

STORY TO SHARE - from Uganda

During the discipleship-mission training, a lesson on forgiveness kept Robert awake all night. For many years, he had not spoken to his uncle, who is also his neighbor, because of conflict between them. Robert said, "I went to his house early in the morning and found him there. I asked him to forgive me, that we could mend our relationship. I told him I also forgave him. He called his wife out and we all talked and forgave each other. Now we are happy, and I have peace inside myself."

Robert mentioned that his uncle has not yet accepted the Gospel but he believes this act of forgiveness can help open the door. The community, too, was amazed at this restoration for everyone knew about the long estrangement. It is a further testimony to God's work.
