Pending change from Licensed for Ministry to Ordained Pastor

Affirmed for Ordination: The Crossings CC Leadership Team (*Tina Snyder, Jess Ebersole, Marvin Nissley, Marlin Martin, Bishop Dave Musser*) affirms Rich Nolt as he plans to shift from the credential of Licensed for Ministry to Ordained Pastor. This change will follow a successful meeting between Rich & Julia Nolt and the LMC Credentialing Committee on June 14, 2023. While this change will not change the current functions of Rich's role, it will cease the "probationary" period of service to a lifelong ministry credential of Ordained Pastor with LMC.

Feedback Opportunity: The Leadership Team and Pastor Rich invite your feedback, input, and suggestions regarding Rich's pastoral leadership functions at Crossings CC. The intent of the feedback is to help Rich be reflective on his pastoral role and provide suggestions for ways to better support and grow pastoral leadership functions.
